

MEDIA AND COMMUNICATION IN THE NETHERLANDS



A group of students from Dr. Nassau College, Assen, the Netherlands, took part in an activity with a topic **“Nature and communication”**, having as a target subject the water, activity included in the IVN project “School for sustainability”.

The activity consists in a research in the field and it is finalized with an app the students realized for the IPAD and iPhone. The app can be used for tourists, in order to better promote the beauties of the Netherlands.



The students, aged 12 to 14, together with experts in water management, biology, underwater photography, found rare species of plants, animals, insects and fish from an area of ... km, in the National Park Drentse Aa, in the neighborhood of Assen. The students made pictures of them, than they made a research on the Internet for finding details and information about the mentioned species of plants, animals etc. and made a short text. The text, together with the photos they made in the nature, were used for making an app, so everybody who visits that area can have access on his/her IPAD or iPhone to the students’ work and the information they summarize inside of the application.

At the moment, **Quarter Mediation** is involved in a transfer of innovation project with the title “The eight methods for fighting early school leaving in VET” and the activity mentioned above is part of the innovation to be transferred from the Netherlands to Italy, Wales and Turkey.
